ABOUT THE HOME

This well-built 135-year-old detached home had a major gut renovation performed about 33 years ago, with a rear 3-level addition. It is in very good condition overall, inside & out, on all 4 levels.

- **Roofing** The 1st half of life asphalt shingles & flat roof modified bitumen are above average quality and can last 20+ years. The rebuilt chimney is for the gas fireplace. There are 2 skylights: 3rd floor bedroom & rear basement stairs.
- **Exterior** Land/hard-scaping has been done. The front porch has steps down to the driveway & wide walkway. The rear door opens onto a raised deck & the backyard.
- Structure The solid masonry walls have a brick foundation. No issues were seen. The addition is a wood structure.
- Electrical There is an upgraded 100amp entry/breaker panel & wiring. Ground fault interrupters were noted.
- Heating The 14-year-old gas-fired high-efficiency furnace can last up to 20 years. It will save energy especially since its combustion air comes from outside.
- Cooling The 13-year-old a/c can last 15+ years.
- Insulation The visible attic has upgraded insulation.
- Plumbing The supply pipe is mostly copper as is the upgraded main line. There is a 2year-old tankless water heater. Waste pipe upgrades have been done. The sump-pump is part of the damp-proofing system. The kitchen, main-floor powder room, two 2nd floor & 3rd floor bathrooms have been done to very good standards.
- Interior Very good quality finishes were noted, and it has been well looked after with obvious signs there is pride of ownership. The windows & doors have been upgraded. The finished addition's basement has a rec' room & laundry room. The original basement is unfinished but in good condition. Each basement has its own staircase.
